ARTS SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Deadline: June 30

CHARLOTTE GLENCROSS SCHOLARSHIP FOR PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT IN THE ARTS

All art forms are eligible. Only New Brunswick residents are eligible to apply. A resident is defined as a Canadian citizen or landed immigrant who has resided in New Brunswick for at least one year immediately preceding the application deadline of June 30.

The Charlotte Glencross Scholarship for Professional Development in the Arts Scholarship is an award that is determined on a competitive basis and requires the submission of sample of work and artist's statement.

REQUIREMENTS

- Résumé (three pages maximum)
- Copy of enrolment confirmation letter
- Copy of program/course description and tuition fee as provided by institution of private instructor
- Résumé of the private instructor (when applicable)
- Sample of work may include coursework or artwork created outside of art courses, preferably within the past two years.
 - for visual arts and craft — a 10 to 20 image portfolio on CD or DVD format, with name, media, dimension, year created, etc.
 - For music — demo on CD or DVD of one to three songs not exceeding a total of 10 minutes; give name of composer and attached music sheets whenever possible
 - for dance and theatre — a DVD of a 10 minutes performance or solo; playwrights must submit at least a 25 page text
 - for literary arts — an applicant must submit a maximum of 25 pages
 - for film or video— a maximum of 10 minute production on DVD. Script writer must submit at least a 25 page text
- Artist's statement should include your reasons for wanting to be an artist, a description of work that you admire, and your academic and artistic goals. Your statement should be 300-500 words (double spaced) in length. Be sure to include your name at the top of your statement.
- Self-addressed, stamped return envelope large enough for portfolio, if you would like it returned. The NBFA is not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged items.
